## \*WORKSHOP A: Needlework with Michele Roberts

"Stitching the Scriptures" is an embroidery workshop on how to create beautiful Christian ornaments or a small framed picture, each of which bears a familiar motto from the New Testament and a golden charm to remind us. Choose one from the following list: New in 2017: "Jesus Christ is Lord" (golden crown charm), "Prince of Peace" (crown), and "Fruits of the Spirit" (Bible with dove and cross). Encore from 2016: "Christ is Risen" (butterfly), "King of Kings" (crown), and "I am the true vine" (grape cluster). Each piece is stitched on white even-weave fabric. Learn how to finish over padded mat boards with gold cords and custom beaded edge. Kits include chart and instructions, embroidery fabric, embroidery threads, the gold charm, padding, mat boards, fabric backing, gold cord, gold braid, beads, lacing thread, and needles. Bring scissors and a pencil. (It isn't necessary to bring frames, as we will be working in hand. Bring additional light and magnification if you feel you may need it.) Kit cost for each scripture ornament: \$20.00 each. Also new this year, a collapsible Easter butterfly container for thread ends, which uses a bangle bracelet and a silver butterfly charm. Kit cost for the snippet saver: \$10.00.



\*WORKSHOP B: Linen making with Alice Scarbrough, former EDOT Altar Guild Directress and National Altar Guild Board member. Whether a purificator, lavabo towel,

corporal or baptismal towel, the steps are similar; the size changes as does the symbol. Kits available for \$25.

\*WORKSHOP C: Prayer Beads with Ally Hardick You will learn what Anglican Prayer Beads are, the history of use, and create a custom set of your own using beads of natural stone, pearl, glass, and wood. You will leave with a custom set of your own, a carrying pouch, and some suggested prayers to use. Cost is \$25 per person

She will bring information and pictures of hundreds of other patterns from which you can select and she will mail them to you after our workshop. Once you get comfortable with the pattern, you can create your own designs as she has done. All supplies will be provided for a fee of \$15.00.
