This is full-time, salaried (exempt) position on a ministerial schedule. A background check and training in the Safe Church programs of the Diocese of Texas will be required.

A vision for ministry that includes both traditional models of youth ministry and non-traditional
efforts like that of CUSE.

A pallet of skills that encompasses both the emotional intelligence necessary for cooperative,
relational ministry and the administrative ability to organize several ministry efforts
simultaneously.

- Develop a strategy for the continued, measurable growth of CUSE

☐ Under the direction of the Minister for Youth and Young Adult Ministry:

- Assist in developing, planning and leading all Youth Ministry events during the program year (Sept. – May).
- Participate in relationship building and direct contact ministry programs that encounter youth outside of the traditional church context.
- Assist in promoting events by communicating with youth and parents via email, phone calls, and social media.
- Attend Cathedral worship services regularly.
- o Support the efforts of the Diocese of Texas Youth Ministry.
