DIRECTOR OF MUSIC

The Director of Music will assume responsibility for all aspects of musical life in the parish including being the Principal Choir Director. S/he will prepare and conduct the current Adult Choir and develop a Children's Choir and maintain and further develop the *Music to Help Others* Concert Series. Responsibilities will include the selection of music for the choir(s) for the singing of anthems and solos as appropriate within the service, recruitment of new choir members, supervision of the organist and other music ministry staff members, hiring of singers and musicians as needed and according to the budget, preparation of the music budget for the choral program for each fiscal year, ensuring the maintenance and care of musical instruments, musical library and choir space and instructing the congregation in the richness of the Episcopal Church's musical heritage. Any candidate should have had some work experience as a choral director. A Bachelor of Music or a Bachelor of Arts degree or higher is preferred.

The Director of Music will work collaboratively with the Rector to plan hymns and other service music for all services, while maintaining primary responsibility for the development of all aspects of musical worship.



THE CHOIR

Twenty-two to twenty-four singers comprise the Adult Choir of Christ Church. Two of these are paid singers with the rest being volunteer members. The choir sings weekly for the Offertory in the late service and does "double-duty" for both services on Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday. The choral season runs from September through May and includes a Wednesday night rehearsal during that time from 6:30-7:30. During the summer season, there are no weekly rehearsals and the summer offertories are a mix of solos, trios, organ offertories, instrumental solos and other musical selections.
